The Great Falls Clinic offers Patient Navigation services for individuals facing the difficult diagnosis of a life-threatening illness or where cancer is suspected.

Patient Navigators specialize in providing personalized healthcare guidance as patients go through the screening process, gain understanding about their diagnosis, make decisions about treatment, and transition from active treatment to survivorship.

To ensure patients receive the best care possible, a Patient Navigator advocates on their behalf, enhancing communication with their providers, coordinating timely treatment, and providing critical support through all stages of their healthcare journey.

- Education for the patient and family regarding the diagnosis, treatment options and cancer care issues
- Identification of potential barriers to treatment, providing resources and referrals to support services
- Coordination of care with healthcare team members throughout the healthcare system
- Assistance with continuity of support while moving from diagnosis through treatment to survivorship
